### **Our Values**

**Teamwork:** We embrace a team approach to improve clinical outcomes and work environment. As part of an orthopedic residency experience, the participant learns what is entailed in being a "good teammate".

**Communication:** We pride ourselves on the highest level of communication with patients, employees, and additional stake holders to ensure everyone has the same goal in mind. As part of an integrated medical team, our residents learn valuable communication skills necessary to interact with patients and all members of the medical team.

**Quality of care:** ATI Physical Therapy employees provide individualized and evidence-based treatment programs to meet our patients' goals. Participation in our residency programs allow participants to gain the tools necessary to provide best in practice care.

**Friendly factor:** We believe in going out of our way to make patients feel welcome and comfortable in a warm and friendly clinic environment. In addition, our residency and fellowship programs offer participants a safe and friendly environment to learn and grow as medical providers.

### **Residency Program Overview**

Our orthopedic residency program run from August through September of the following year. We take between 3-5 residents in each program depending on our clinic availability, candidates, and mentors. Our program is offered in Greenville, South Carolina.

Residents treat patients between 32 and 40 hours per week (decided by the resident with pay adjusted for clinical hours) with an additional 4 hours of mentorship, 3-4 hours of specialty practice observation, and 4 hours of didactic/Journal club each week.

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Our residents rotate between different clinics to different patient populations as well as different mentors. Our residents typically treat in 2-4 clinics throughout their year. All clinics are within driving distance of from their central location.

The residency is valued at 15,000, and we provide full coverage of that cost with a 2-year commitment to ATI following successful completion of the residency which can be served at any location with an open position in the company.

**Admission Requirements**

Residents must be licensed clinicians at the time they start the residency program in the state where they are practicing (usually SC). We are looking for candidates who are willing to learn, have a strong passion for their area of interest, are flexible, and demonstrate effective communication and team work.
